



WAIVER TO CARRY MEDICATION

Waiver for Students Who Must Carry Medication on Their Person According to Tennessee Statute 49-5-415:

Any student that must carry a medication on their person during school hours must provide a “written statement from the prescribing health practitioner” and also have “been instructed in the self-administration of the prescribed” medication. Also required in this statute, is a statement acknowledging that the school and employees would incur no liability should any injury be sustained by the student during self-administration of this medication during school hours. To meet all state regulations, we are now requiring a doctor’s signature and a signed waiver of liability if you feel that your student must carry their medication independently. We will need this form signed and returned no later the first week of school. We appreciate your understanding and patience as we strive to maintain optimal safety for your student here at Macon Road Baptist School.
